## We are Proud of our entrepreneurs...



The concept of honoring entrepreneurs created began at the NBPC 2016. 4 Entrepreneurs from I Create Safar, Mumbai were honored by the Khemka Family. Their success stories are given below.

**Narendra Pitroda, Quilt Culture, Rohini and Uttam Mohite (L-R)**

- **Narendra Pitroda** was affected by polio since birth, his father died when he was a year old and his grandfather took the responsibility of looking after him. His mother started to stitch blouses to earn some money to run the family. Narendra studied till 12<sup>th</sup> but was uninterested in continuing his education and wanted to help his mother by sharing the family burden. He passed diploma in tailoring (Government certificate course) in 2003. His disability prevented him from looking for a job outside. He decided to expand his mother's business by helping her. He got operated on his polio affected leg and was partially cured to pursue his tailoring business. He heard about I Create training and attended the workshop which gave him the much needed confidence to expand his business. Today he owns a shop in Thane and has four stitching machines and gets orders from nearby colleges to stitch designer clothes.
- **Archana** has been working as a social worker and freelance journalist from Kondhava since a decade now. **Rucha** is a concept-based visual artist who works with several social issues and tries to contribute to them through art projects. They started **Quilt Culture** with the objective of giving employment to less privileged women and retaining the Maharashtrian tradition of quilt making—Godhadi. Initially, Quilt Culture started with bedding solutions like quilts, bed spreads, pillow covers, bolster covers, etc., but over the last few months they have introduced yoga mat bags, ladies jackets, tea coasters and some other products. Rucha and Archana attended the workshop for young entrepreneurs organized by I Create India in May 2015, which gave them the confidence to start up Quilt Culture.
- **Uttam Mohite**, 28 years old had always been very ambitious to achieve success in life. Success evaded him as he had no proper guidance. He worked with his cousin and learnt the nuances of the construction business, but was still not very confident of starting anything on his own. The training at I Create helped him to learn the step by step procedure of launching his own Construction Business. This learning gave him the much needed inspiration and the courage to launch his own Construction company.- **Ajintha Builders**
- **Rohini** had completed an advanced course of Garment manufacturing and fashion designing from RVTI Dadar and was working in various places before she decided to start her business. She attended the Workshop organized by I Create Safar in 2011; the workshop helped her in promoting her Business successfully. Today she has 4 sewing machines and gets big orders from her friends and others Her dream is to open her own boutique.
