Mentor and Angel Group of I Create (MAGIC) is a revolving fund, created from the donations of many organizations and individuals, to be able to provide "bridge" loan or full funding to I Create trained *wantapreneurs.* This is a no-interest but reasonableservice-fee assistance model. The amount provided is returnable to ensure the "revolving" nature of the Fund.

MAGIC was started with the idea of addressing the problem faced by micro entrepreneurs in accessing capital of small magnitude (Rs.25,000 to 50,000).

In the absence of MAGIC, options available to these entrepreneurs were:

(i) Micro Finance Institutions, whose interest charges were not commensurate with the level of return the micro enterprises would generate, or

(ii) Various government schemes being implemented by financial institutions, where the bureaucracy was daunting and entrepreneurs would soon get frustrated and lose hope.
